Etiquette Agreement – Rec the River

1. Respect Nature:

- a. Leave No Trace: Pack out all trash and leave the natural surroundings as you found them.
- b. No littering: Dispose of waste responsibly in designated bins.

2. Campground Etiquette:

- a. Wear Wristband at all times- this is your campground pass.
- b. Camp only in designated areas.
- c. Keep Noise levels to a minimum, be respectful especially during the quieter hours.
- d. Be mindful of your neighbors and maintain a clean campsite.

3. River Floating:

- a. Be prepared with appropriate gear, including life jackets if needed, sunscreen, river shoes, & drinking water.
- b. Do not litter in the river, bring trash back to shore for proper disposal.
- c. Stay together as group and be aware of other floaters.
- d. Make sure to check out and back in with float coordinator or RTR staff. We do not want to lose anyone on the river!

4. Tree Climbing:

- a. Only climb trees designated as safe for climbing.
- b. Use proper safety equipment, such as harnesses and helmets, & Eye protection.
- c. Do not damage the tree in any way.

5. **Demonstration/ Presentation Participation**:

- a. Arrive on time for demonstration and respect the presenter's schedule.
- b. Participate actively and respectfully in discussions and activities.
- c. Follow any specific guidelines provided by demonstrator.

6. Fire Safety:

- a. Obey all fire regulations and restrictions.
- b. Use designated fire pits or grills for cooking or campfires.
- c. Completely extinguish fires before leaving them unattended.

7. Alcohol and Substance Use:

- a. Consume alcohol responsibly and in moderation.
- b. Do not use illegal substances on the premises.
- c. Respect the personal choices of others regarding substance use.
- d. Remember this is a family friendly event.

8. Personal Safety:

- a. Be aware of your surroundings and exercise caution in unfamiliar areas.
- b. Stick with the group when engaging in activities such as river floating.
- c. Report any safety concerns or emergencies to event staff immediately.

9. Community Respect:

- a. Treat all participants, staff, and volunteers with kindness and respect.
- b. Be mindful of personal space and boundaries.

- a. Failure to comply with these rules may result in expulsion from the event with out refund.
